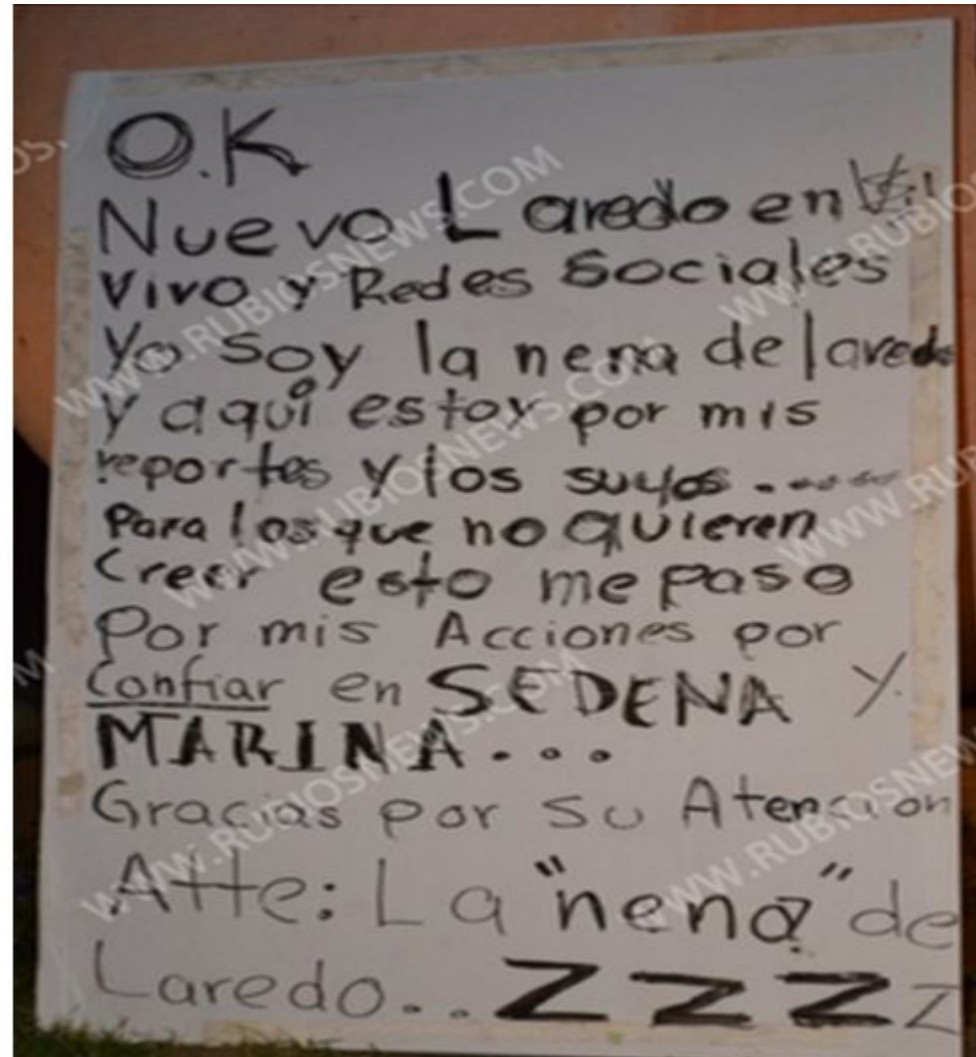

El diseñador Mario Flores Vargas, de 28 años, quien es conocido en Twitter como @mareoflores, fue detenido por aproximadamente 12 agentes de la Procuraduría General de la República (PGR) afuera de su domicilio ubicado en la colonia Popotla “por un tuit que publicó” el pasado jueves, informó uno de sus familiares.

De acuerdo con Mario Flores Vega, padre del detenido, de un convoy de cinco vehículos bajaron los agentes y “sometieron a golpes al diseñador” y lo trasladaron a las instalaciones de la dependencia de Plaza de la República número 30 para que rinda su declaración “por cuál motivo, no sabemos”, agregó el tutor en entrevista con este medio.

THE SURVEY

- A 21-question electronic survey was distributed to a group of trusted journalists, bloggers and human rights defenders.
- The results offer quantitative evidence on the digital and mobile vulnerability of journalists and bloggers working in high risk areas of Mexico.

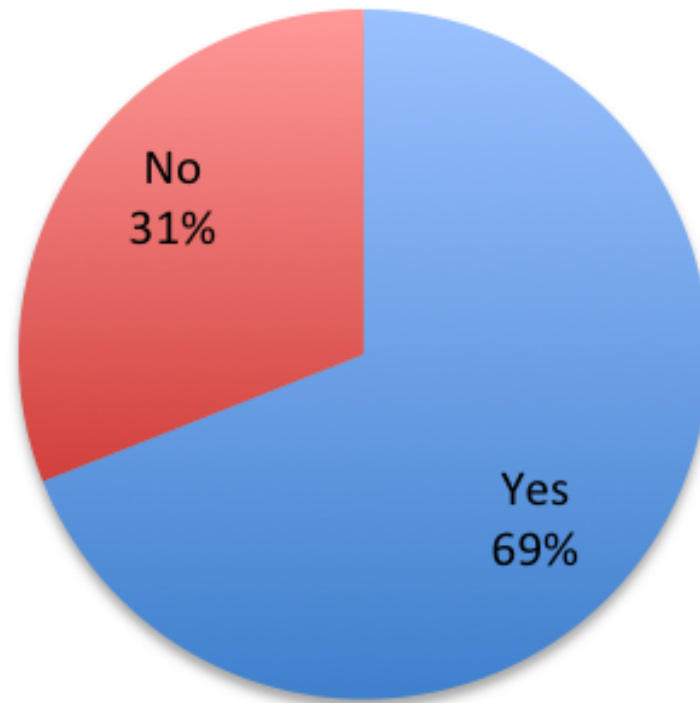

BIGGEST PHYSICAL RISK

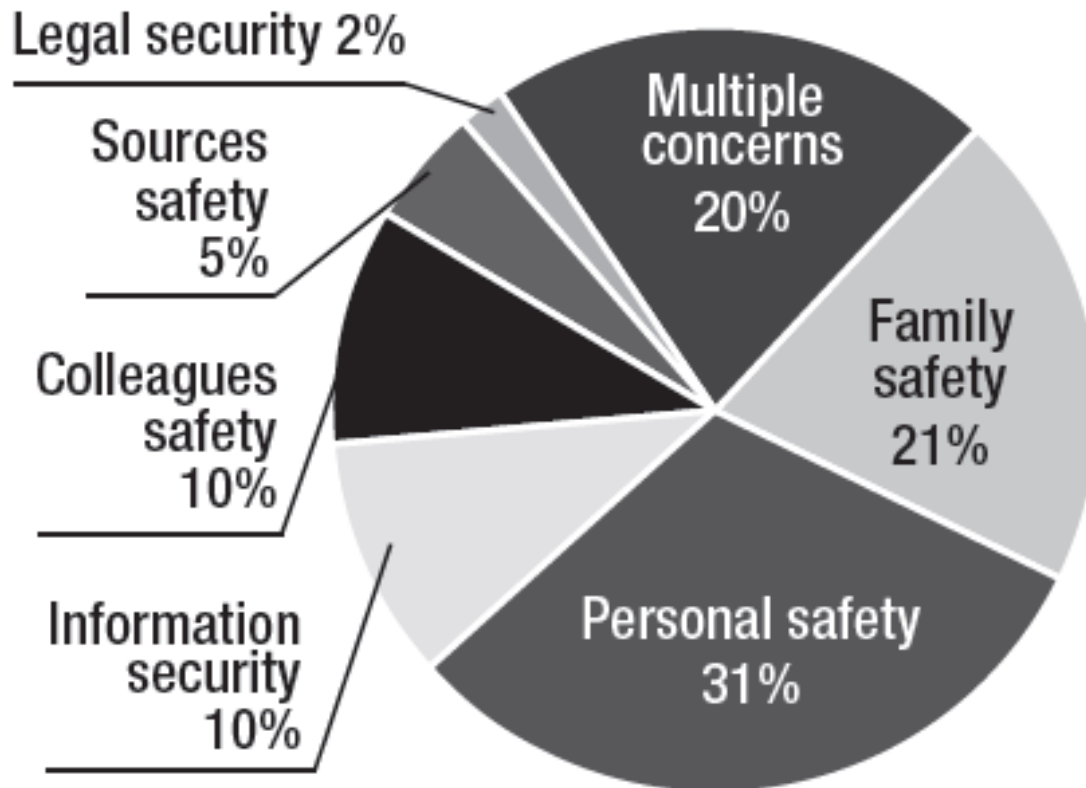

None of the respondents claimed they face a risk of extortion.

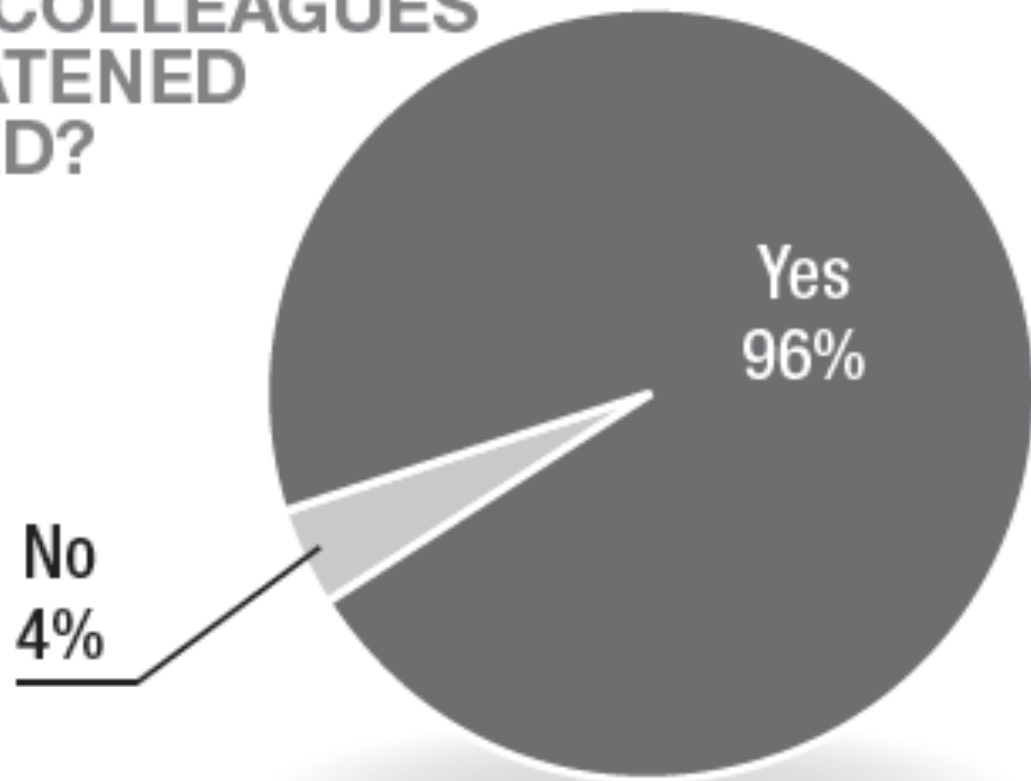

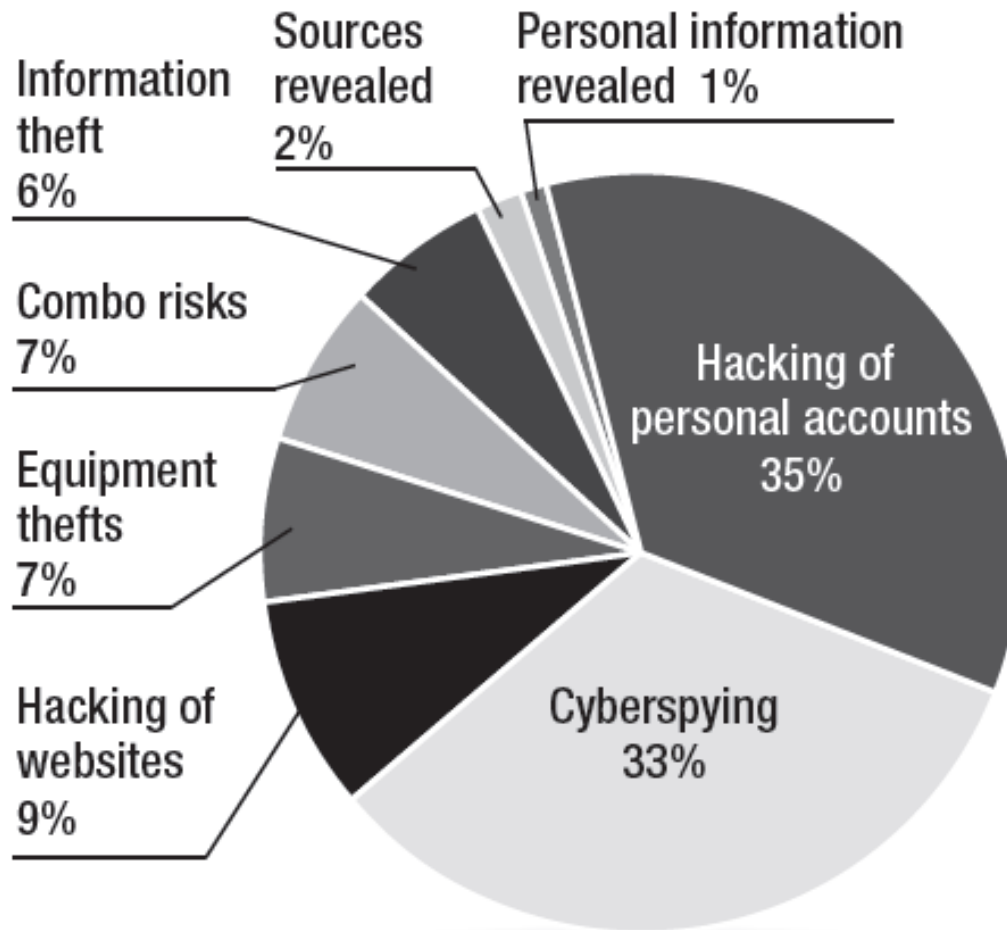

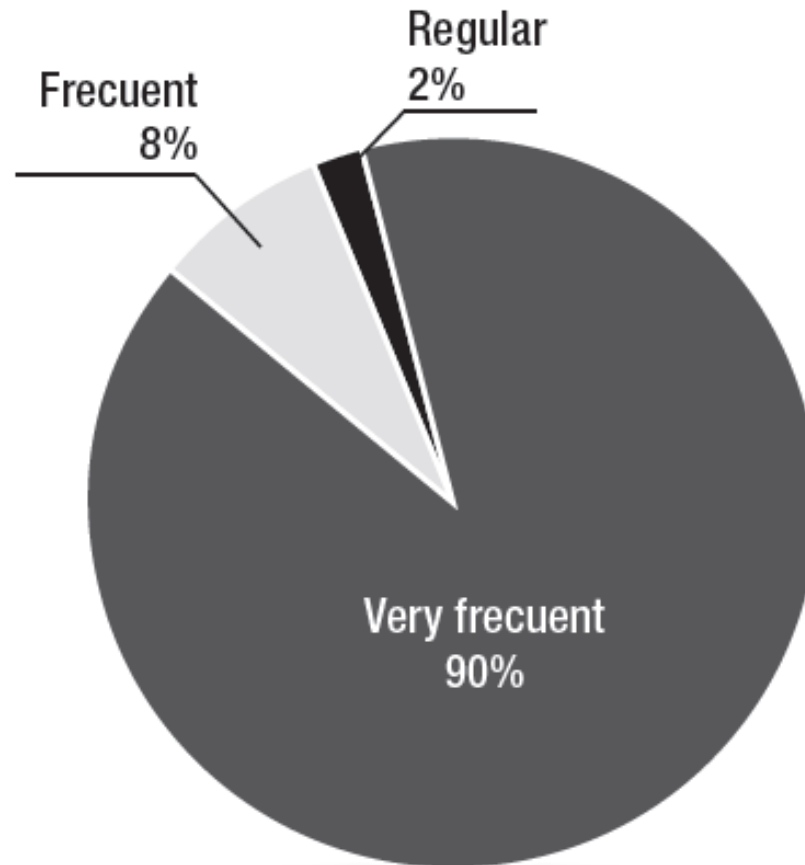

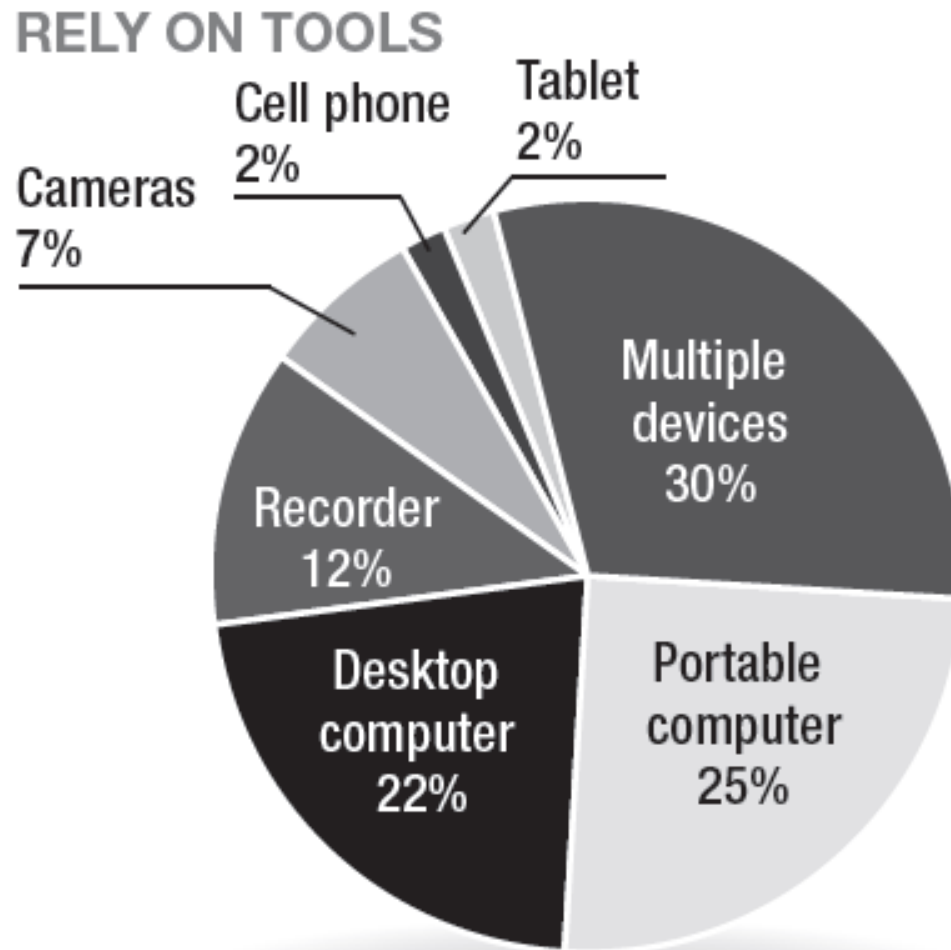

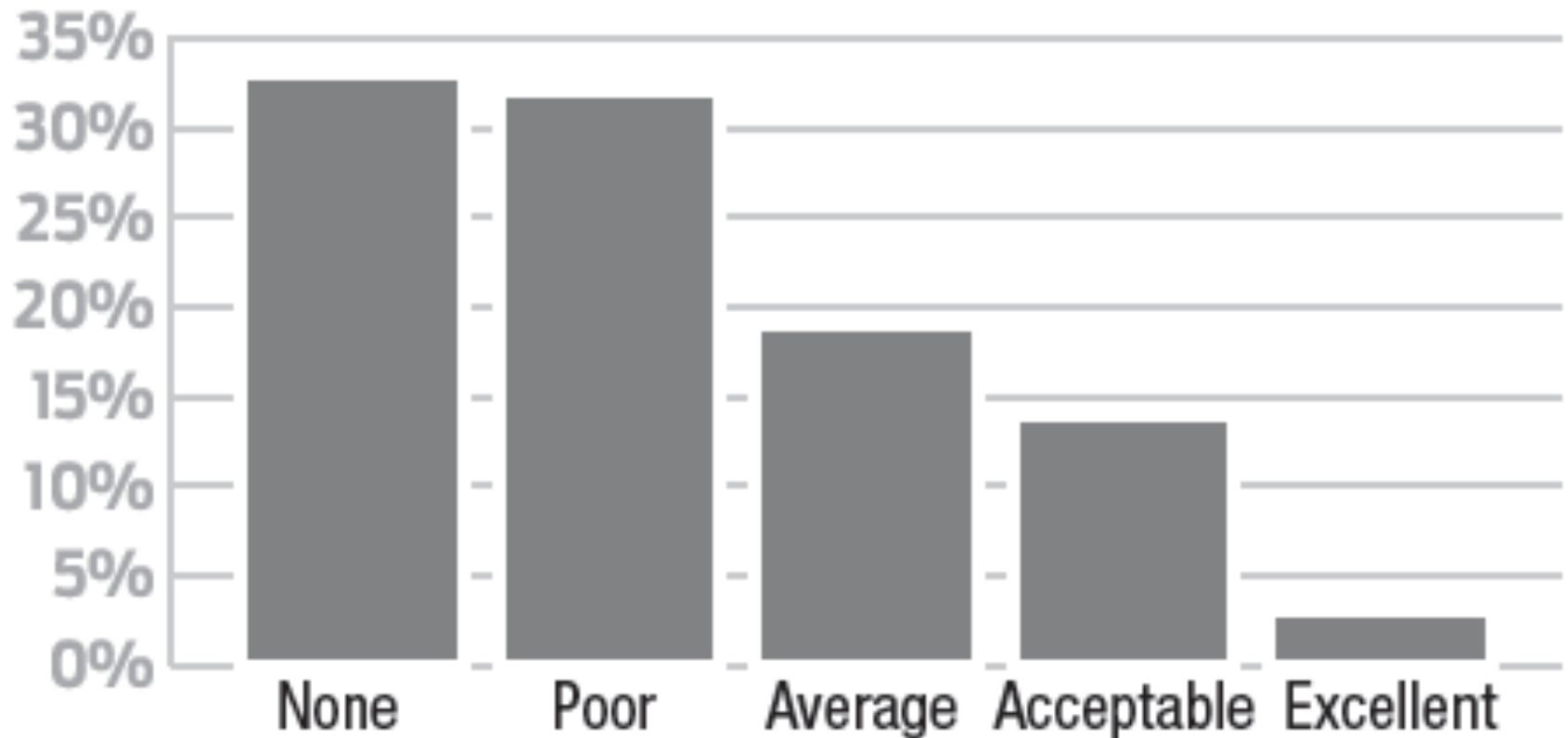

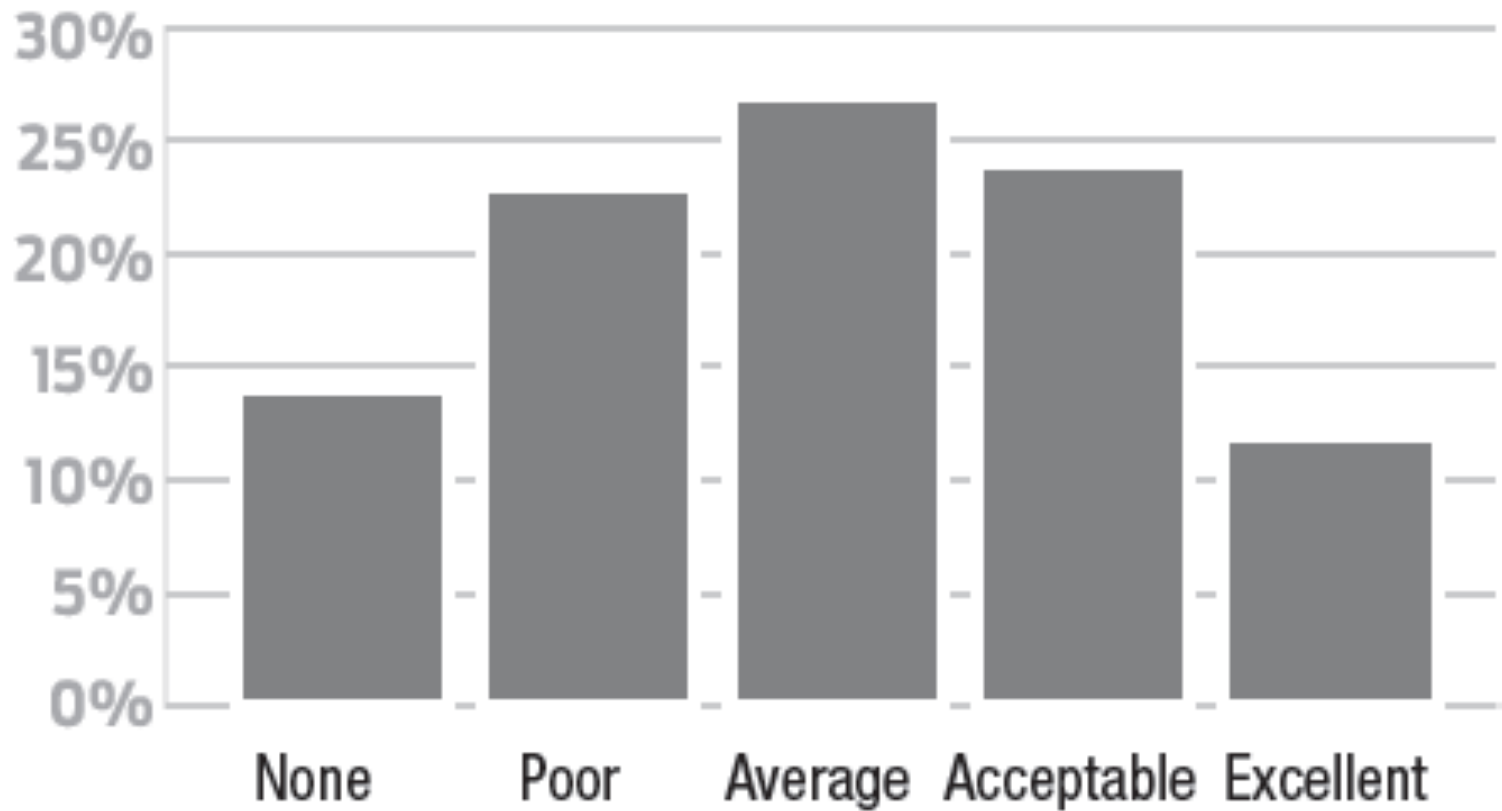

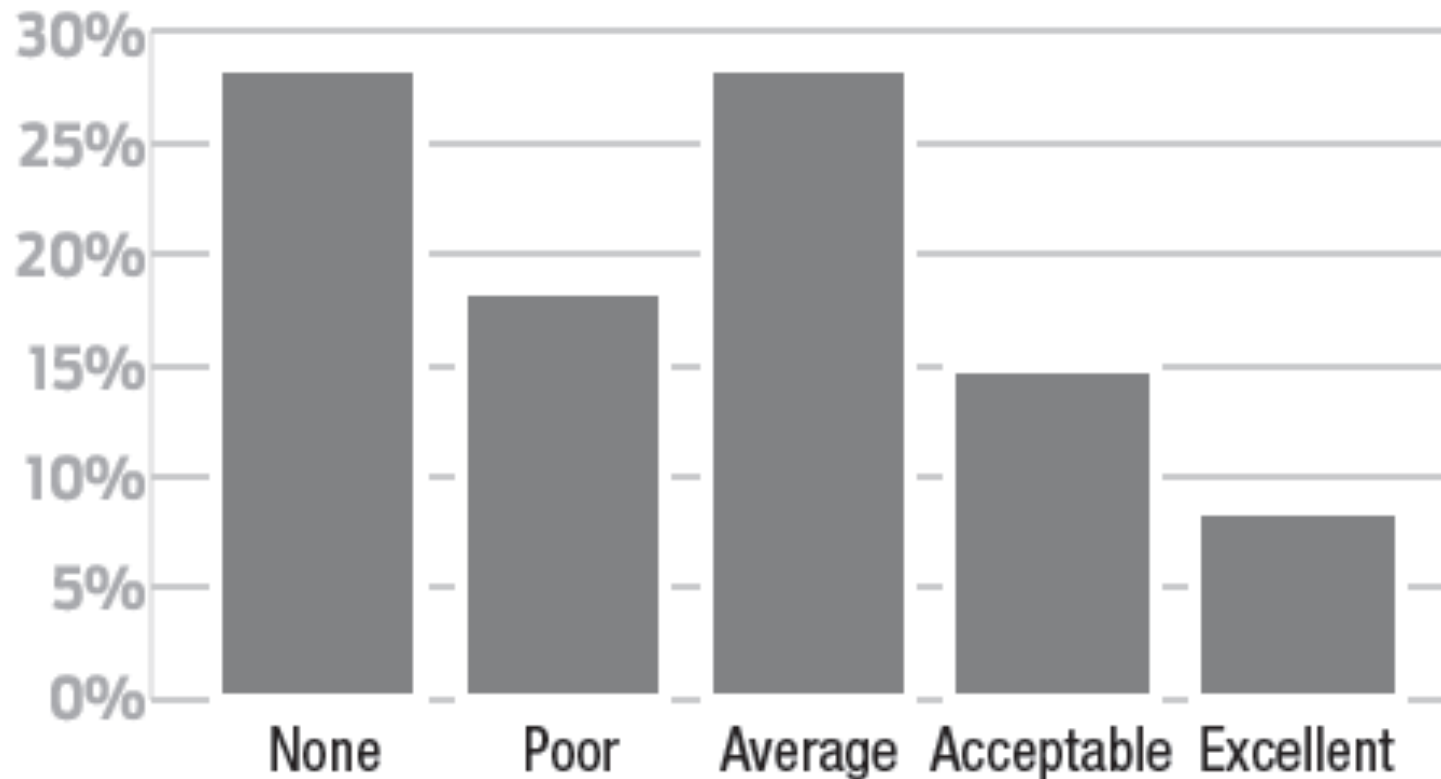

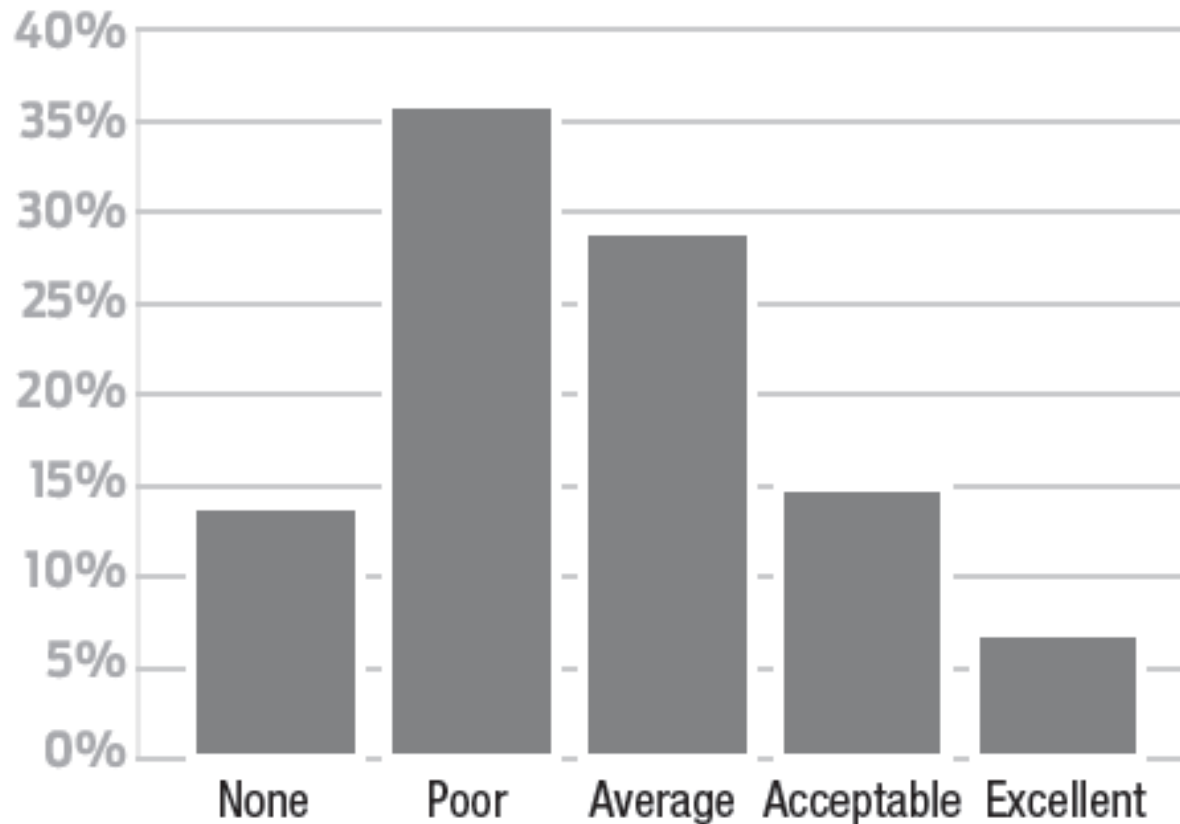

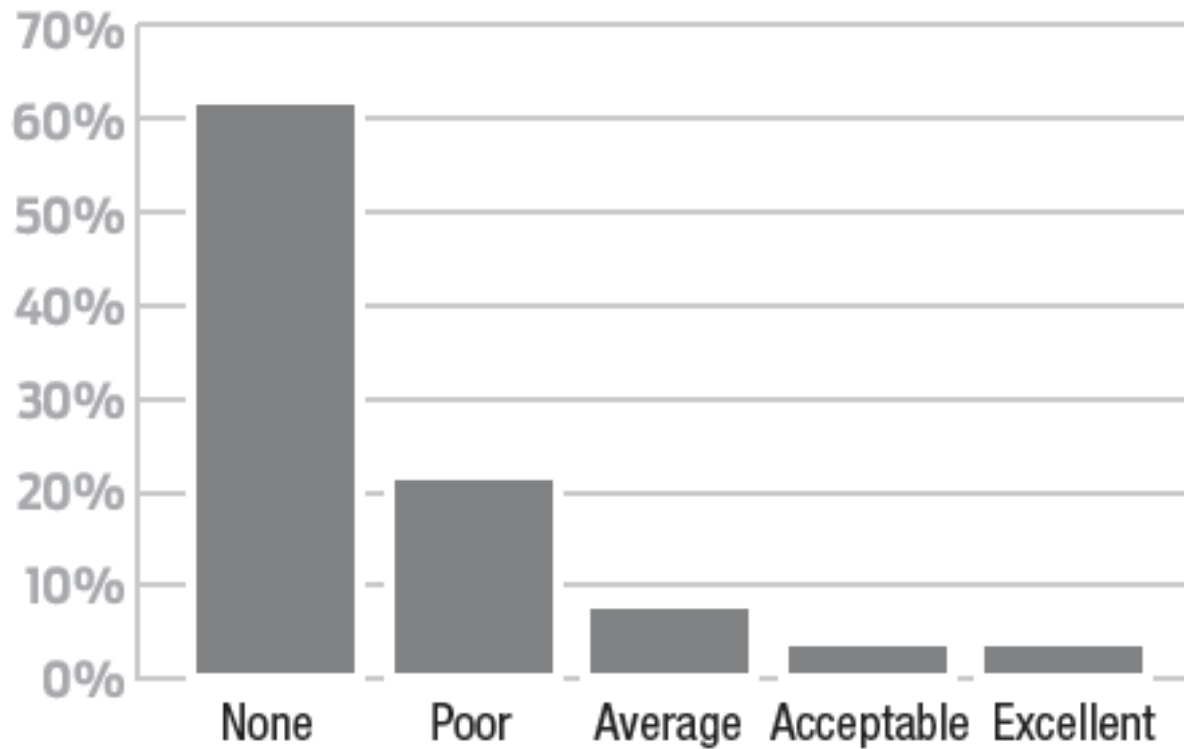

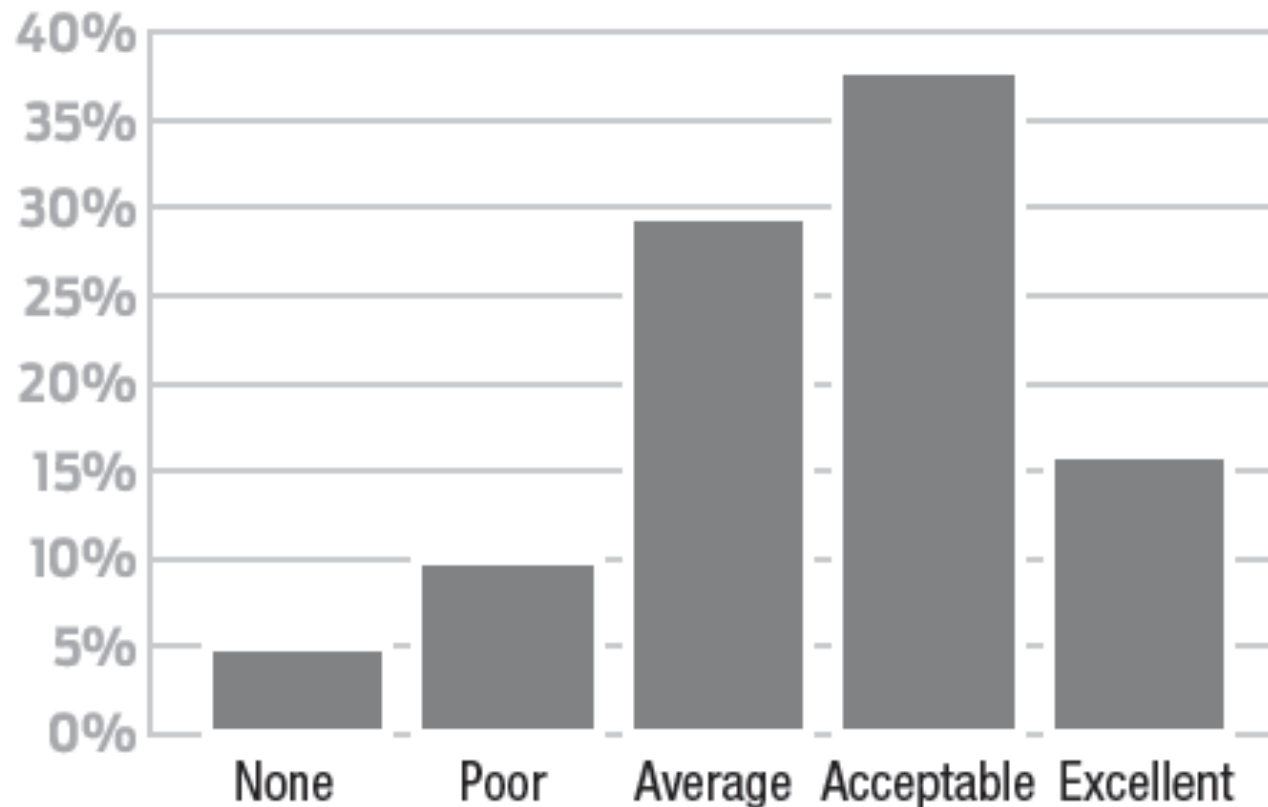

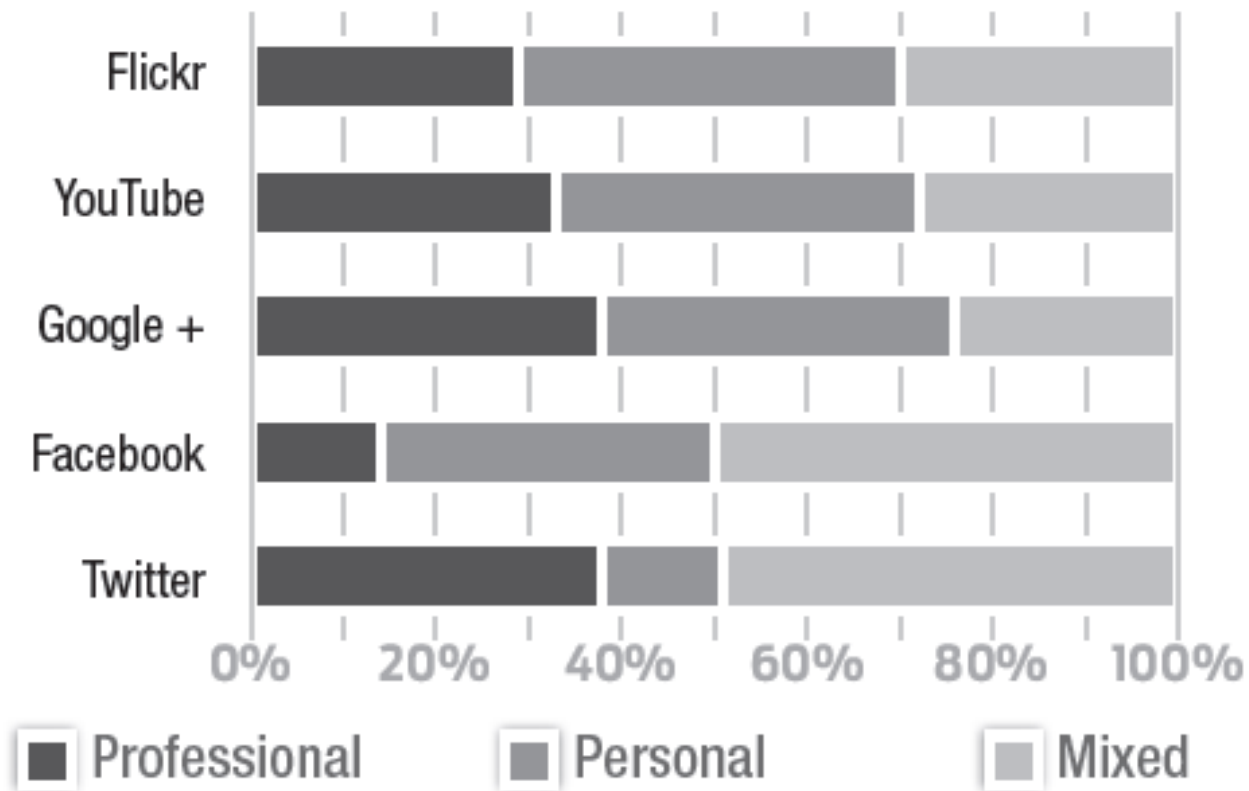

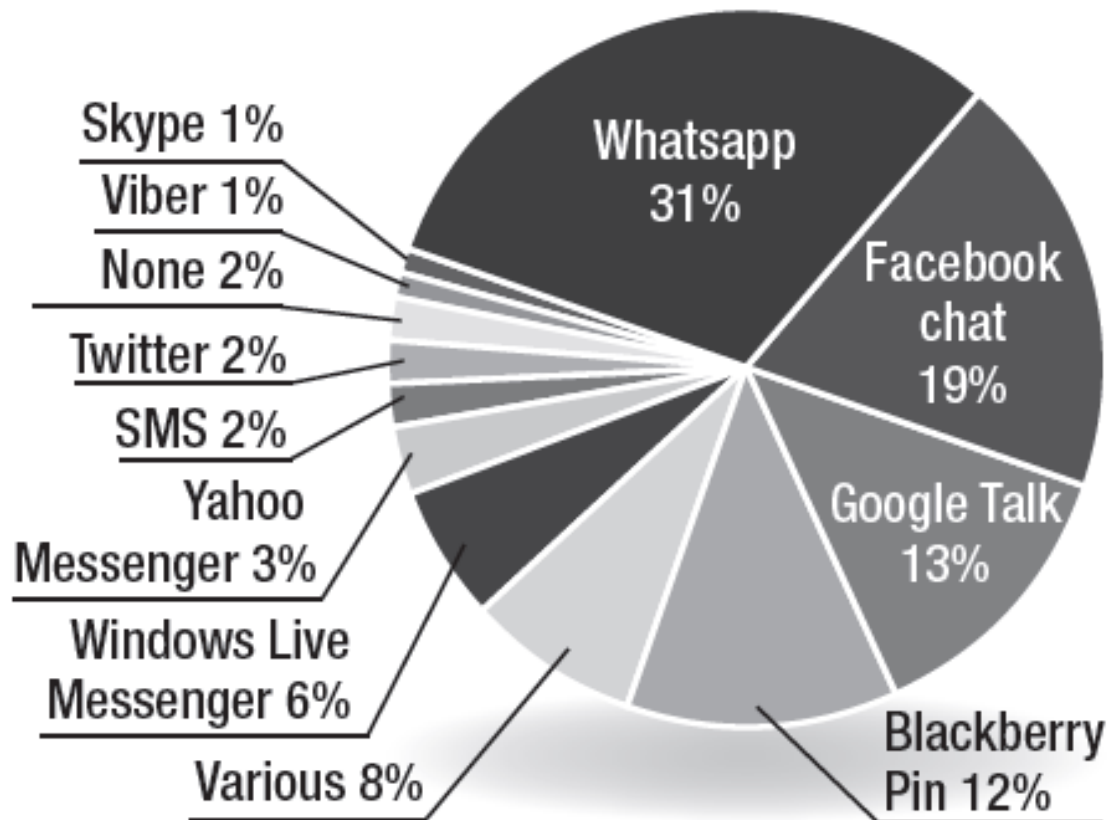
